# Saddletime Description

Saddletime is a moderate energy, pelleted feed suitable for maintenance, light or medium exercised horses. The formulation draws energy primarily from carbohydrates, which provide rapidly metabolized energy. The complete nutrient balance of minerals and vitamins helps maintain long-term health particularly of the hair and hooves. Brooks proven quality and drug free manufacturing facilities ensure satisfaction and complete confidence at a cost comparable to competitive feeds.

Saddletime supplies total nutrition in a palatable pelleted form that horses take to readily and stay on while training or performing.

## Feeding Suggestions

Feed horses according to level and type of activity and to maintain ideal body condition.

Mature Weight	900 lbs. (400 kg.)	1100 lbs. (500 kg.)	1300 lbs. (600 kg.)
Idle horses	3-5 lbs. (1.5-2.5 Kg.)	4-6 lbs. (2.0-2.75 kg.)	5-8 lbs. (2.5-3.5 kg.)
Light work *	4-6 lbs. (2.0-2.75 kg.)	5-6 lbs. (2.5-2.75 kg.)	6-9 lbs. (3.0-4.0 kg.)
Moderate work **	6-9 lbs. (3.0-4.0 kg.)	9-11 lbs. (4.0-5.0 kg.)	11-13 lbs. (5.0-6.0 kg.)

\* ie. jogging, trail riding, pleasure etc.

\*\* ie. dressage, jumping, cutting, roping etc.

*Note: Warmblood and Draft type horses may require different amounts from light horse breeds.

Amount of feed required is dependant on the body condition, the metabolism and the type of activity the horse is used for. For each pound of *Saddletime* fed daily below ½ pound per 100 pounds of the horse's bodyweight add ¼ pound (115 grams) *Brooks Enhancer* or *All Phase 20*. For specific recommendations consult a Brooks Feed representative or submit a request on-line using our interactive feeding guide. Provide fresh clean water and free choice salt at all times with a minimum of 1% of the horse's bodyweight in hay or equivalent pasture. Store in a cool dry location. Amount fed varies according to the quality of hay or pasture. Hay analysis is recommended to ensure a balanced ration.
